Sheriff Doyle Sworn in as ISA President

Putnam County Sheriff Kevin Doyle was sworn in to serve as 2022 President of the Illinois Sheriffs' Association (ISA) at the Sheriffs Winter Training Conference in East Peoria, IL.

Executive committee members are responsible for directing the association in the development of policy and legislation encompassing all facets of law enforcement, corrections and court security as well as developing programs that encourage professional growth.

The ISA was founded in 1928 to facilitate communication and cooperation between Sheriffs and encourage more professional training and growth. Now in its 94th year, the association continues to foster that communication, and has become a leader in offering innovating training programs for Illinois Sheriff's and their support teams. The Association also serves as a liaison with Illinois legislators, both introducing and tracking bills that will impact the criminal justice system in Illinois and focuses on today's youth, which hold the key to society's future. The ISA encourages youth by supporting and creating various youth-oriented programs and offering scholarships.

Sheriff Kevin Doyle was elected Putnam County Sheriff in 1998 and is currently serving his sixth term. Sheriff Doyle is in his 29th year of Law Enforcement. After receiving his bachelor's degree in Social Justice from Sangamon State University, he began his career as a deputy for the Putnam County Sheriff's Office.

Sheriff Doyle has served on multiple boards and organizations throughout his career. He has held the position of Chairman of the 911 Emergency Telephone System Board since 2000. Sheriff Doyle has served on the Executive Board for the Illinois Sheriffs' Association since 2015. He served 10 years as Chairman of the Illinois Sheriffs' Association Training Committee. Sheriff Doyle also served as Vice President of the TRIDENT Drug Task Force, CFO for the Illinois Valley Crime Prevention Commission and the Executive Board for Freedom House. Sheriff Doyle was also the 2008 recipient of the Governor's Award of Excellence for Individual Achievement.
